Originally established by GLO in 1880 with a cedar post and 2 BT's. Subsequently restored in 1989 by Roy Gaylord, LS 18731, with a 1" iron pipe with stamped brass cap.

Above described pipe and cap.  
24" fir stump at N62E 8.5 feet with axe marks and scribing.
