Chapter 315, Laws of 1986:

- (1) If no later than thirty days after removal of classification or designation the owner applies for classification under RCW 84.34.020 (2) or (3), then the classified or designated forest land shall not be considered removed from classification or designation for purposes of compensating tax under RCW 84.33.120 or 84.33.140 until the application for current use classification under RCW 84.34.030 is denied or the property is removed from designation under RCW 84.34.108. Upon removal from designation under RCW 84.34.108, the amount of compensating tax due under this chapter shall be equal to:
 - (a) The difference, if any, between the amount of the assessed valuation on such land as forest land and the amount of the new assessed valuation of such land when removed from designation under RCW 84.34.108 multiplied by the dollar rate of the last levy extended against such land, multiplied by
 - (b) A number equal to:
 - (i) The number of years the land was classified or designated under this chapter, if the total number of years the land was classified or designated under this chapter and classified under chapter 84,34 RCW is less than ten; or
 - (ii) Ten minus the number of years the land was classified under chapter 84.34 RCW, if the total number of years the land was classified or designated under this chapter and classified under chapter 84.34 RCW is at least ten.
- (2) Nothing in this section authorizes the continued classification or designation under this chapter or defers or reduces the compensating tax imprised upon forest land not transferred to classification under subsection (1) of this section which does not meet the recessary definitions of forest land under RCW 84.33.100. Nothing in this section affects the additional tax i nposed under RCW 84.34.108.

The application for transfer from classified or designated forest land to current use classification, form and agricultural or timber land must be made within 30 days from the date of removal from forest land.

The county assessor will apriove all applications for transfer to farm and agricultural classification.

In all unincorporated areas, he legislative authority shall act as the granting authority for applications for transfer to timber land classification. It ands within the incorporated areas shall be acted upon by a group composed of three members of the county legislative authority and three members of the city legislative authority.

Compensating tax will be due at the time of sale or transfer of any portion of land unless the application for classification is approved. If only a portion of the pancel listed on the application qualifies for classification the granting authority may approve only that part.

An application fee of not more than \$30 shall accompany each separate application. If the application is denied, all fees will be returned to applica it.

- (a) Any land area so designated by an official comprehensive land use plan adopted by any city or county and zoned accordingly, or
- (b) Any land area, the preservation of which in its present use would (i) conserve and enhance natural or scenic resources, or (ii) protect streams or water supply, (iii) promote conservation of soils, wetlands, beaches or tidal marshes, or (iv) enhance the value to the public of abutting or neighboring parks, forests, wildlife preserves, nature reservations or sanctuaries or other open space, or (v) enhance recreation opportunities or (vi) preserve historic sites, or (vii) retain in its natural state tracts of land not less than five acres situated in an urban area and open to public use on such conditions as may be reasonably required by the legislative body granting the open space classification.

STATEMENT OF ADDITIONAL TAX, INTEREST AND PENALTY DUE UPON REMOVAL FROM CLASSIFICATION UNDER RCW 84.34

- Upon removal, an additional tax shall be imposed which shall be due and payable to the county treasurer 30 days after removal or upon sale or transfer, unless the new owner has signed the Notice of Continuance. The additional tax shall be the sum of the following:
 - (a) The difference between the property tax paid as "Open Space Land" or "Timber Land" and the amount of property tax otherwise due and payable for the seven years last past had the land not been so classified; plus
 - (b) Interest upon the amounts of the difference (a), paid at the same sixtutory rate charged on the delinque it property taxes.
 - A penalty of 20% shall be applied to the additional tax if the classified land is applied to some other use, except through compliance with the property owner's request for removal process, or except as a result of those conditions listed in (2)
- 2. The additional tax, interest and penalty specified in (1) above shall not be imposed if the removal resulted solely from:
 - (a) Transfer to a government entity in exchange for other land located within the State of Washington.
- (b) A taking through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or sale or transfer to an entity having the power of eminent domain in anticipation of the exercise of such power.
- (c) Sale or transfer of land within two years after the death of the owner of at least a fifty percent interest in such land.
- (d) A natural disaster such as a flood, windstorm, earthquake, or other such calamity rather than by virtue of the act of the landowner changing the use of such property.
- (e) Official action by an agency of the State of Washington or by the county or city within which the land is located which disallows the present use of such land.
- Transfer to a church and such land would qualify for property tax exemption pursuant to RCW 84.36.020.
- Acquisition of property interests by State agencies or agencies or organizations qualified under RCW 84.34.210 and 64.04.130 (See RCW 84.34.108(5g).
