- DURATION. The durable power of attorney becomes effective as provided in Paragraph 3 and shall remain in effect to the extent permitted by RCW 11.52 of the 1974 Probate Act or until revoked or terminated under paragraph 5 and 6, notwithstanding any uncertainty as to whether the undersigned is dead or alive.
- REVOCATION. This power of attorney may be revoked, suspended or terminated in writing by the undersigned with written notice to the designated attorney-in-fact and by recording the written instrument of revocation in the office of=f the auditor of County, Washington.
