6. There were no estate taxes due as a result of GEORGE O. NICHOLS' demise.

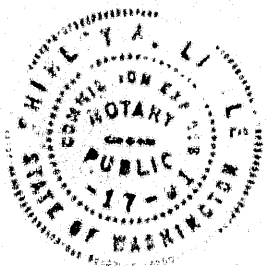
