

GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

THOMAS J. MURPHY, the Archbishop of Seattle, organized pursuant to RCW 24.12 as a Corporate sole known as the Corporation of the Catholic Archbishop of Seattle with principal offices located at 910 Marion Street, Seattle, King County, Washington does hereby make, constitute and appoint ALBERTA HORN, PATRICK J. SURSELY and GEORGE L. THOMAS each individually and not jointly the true and lawful attorney(s)-in-fact for said corporation for the purposes of executing and delivering deeds or other instruments of conveyance, mortgages and any instrument affecting real or personal property, all written contracts including promissory notes and bonds made in connection with the business affairs of said corporation; also with powers to bargain for, buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, and in any way and manner deal in and with goods, wares and merchandise, choses in action, and other property in possession or in action, and to make, do and transact all and every kind of business, of any nature and kind whatsoever, and also to act on behalf of said corporation as an act of the corporation to sign, seal, execute, deliver and acknowledge such deeds, leases and assignments of leases, covenants, indentures, agreements, mortgages, hypothecations, evidence of debt, releases and satisfaction of mortgage, judgments and other debts, and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind or nature, as may be necessary or proper in the premises.

Said attorney(s)-in-fact are also given full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to the execution of the powers herein granted as fully to all intents and purposes as the Archbishop could do if personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming all that said attorney(s)-in-fact shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this power of attorney. Each attorney-in-fact has these powers individually and separate from the others and any one of them has the power to act alone pursuant to the authority of this power of attorney.

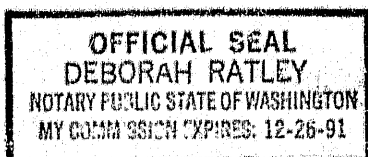
