

In 1935 the U.S. Engineering Department surveying for the Bonneville Project found a stake with bearing trees and set a monument. (Bonneville Project - Lands Ref # R 0-17-6 W.S.)

Olson Engineering found a brass cap in this position 2724.02 feet North of the South line of Section 27, Township 3 North, Range 8 East.


