PROVISIONS

"A low flow of 175 cubic feet per second, as measured at the United States Geological Survey gaging station #114143500, located in the SW¼SE¼ of Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 4 East, W.M., is recommended by the Departments of Fisheries and Wildlife. Accordingly, water allocated under this permit is limited to in-house domestic use only."

"At such a time as flows are established on this stream by statutory procedures, in accordance with Chapter 90.22 RCW of Chapter 90.54 RCW, this permit shall be conditioned to the extent of the new setting, provided that, the permittee would not be subject to a flow requirement of greater than the flow specified above."

At such time that the Department of Ecology determines the regulation and management of the subject waters is necessary and in the public interest, an approved measuring device shall be installed and maintained in accordance with RCW 90.03.360 and WAC 508-64-020 through -040.

The Water Resources Act of 1971 specifies certain criteria regarding utilization and management of the waters of the state in the best public interest. Use of water may be subject to regulation at certain times, based on the necessity to maintain water quantities sufficient for preservation of the natural environment.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
