

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF DIVISION OF LAND
FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING FINANCING

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, on oath depose and
state:

1. We are the Grantors and Grantees under the foregoing Quit
Claim Deed dated the 23rd day of May, 1996 for the property
described in Exhibit A to said Quit Claim Deed.
2. The deed is being given by Grantors to Grantees in order
to assist Grantees in the relocation of their family residence,
their existing family home having been severely damaged by the
February 1996 flooding damage in Skamania County, Washington.
3. The property of which the above-described parcel is a
part was short platted in 1995, and therefore, under County
ordinance, may not be further short platted for a period of five
years; provided, however, that the undersigned submit that an
exception may be made to said limitation by reason of the
following:

- a. Pursuant to Skamania County Ordinance 17.64.040 F.,
this division of land is given for the sole purpose of obtaining
financing for the placement of a building for residential purposes

thereon, and is not an avoidance of the short plat regulations set out in Skamania County Code, Title 17;

b. Neither the Grantees nor Grantors will sell, lease or transfer ownership of the above-described parcel of land separately from Lot 2 of the Lazelle Coates Short Plat until such time that the above-described parcel is legally created as a separately saleable lot as set out in Skamania County Code Title 17.

c. The above-described parcel will remain subject to all other County and State laws, including but not limited to the size of lots as is now provided by all ordinances now existing or hereafter amended; and

d. The County Commissioners of Skamania County, Washington have adopted Resolution 1996-15 declaring that an emergency exists in Skamania County due to flood disaster damage, which Resolution authorizes the Planning Department to accelerate projects directly related to the relocating of personal and real property due to the flood disaster of February 1996.
