

CONTINUED LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR PROPERTY ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: That part of Beacon Rock State Park in Section 25, 26, and 36, Township 2 North, Range 6 East, W.M., described as follows: In Section 25: Beginning at a point on the east line of the Elizabeth Snoo's D.L.C. No. 37, 600 feet south of the northeast corner thereof; thence north 42°43' west to a point on the northerly Right-of-Way line of State Route No. 14 (formerly State Highway No. 8) and the initial point of this description; thence continue north 42°43' west to north line of said D.L.C.; thence west 3,670 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner of said D.L.C.; thence south along west line of said D.L.C. to the northerly Right-of-Way of the Burlington Northern Railway (formerly Spokane, Portland, and Seattle Railway); thence northeasterly along said Right-of-Way to a point 1,000 feet west of the east line of said D.L.C.; thence north to a point on the north Right-of-Way line of said State Route No. 14 (formerly State Highway No. 8); thence northerly along said Right-of-Way to the point of beginning; AND: Government Lots 8, 9, and 10; AND: The west half of Government Lot 11; AND: That part of Government Lot 5 lying easterly of the Right-of-Way of Burlington Northern Railway (formerly Spokane, Portland, and Seattle Railway) and all shorelands in front of, and abutting, this tract; and the east 132 feet of said Government Lot 5;


AND: In Section 26: Beginning at the east quarter corner of said section; thence west 405 feet; thence south 23°40' east 249.9 feet, more or less; thence south 60°20' west 137.7 feet, more or less, to the east boundary of Kuffler County Road; thence southeasterly along said east boundary to its intersection with the center line of the Old State Highway, a distance of 250 feet, more or less; thence northeasterly along said center line to its intersection with the east line of said Section; thence north to point of beginning; AND: In Section 26: Commencing at the quarter corner on the east line of said Section 26; thence westerly along the centerline of said Section 26 a distance of 550 feet to a stake 3 inch square from which a fir tree 4 inch in diameter bears south 45° east 3 feet marked "P"; thence south 200 feet to the northerly line of Kuffler Road (witness a maple tree 14 inch in diameter marked "P"); thence following the northerly and easterly line of said Kuffler Road in a southeasterly direction 365 feet, more or less, to the intersection with the northerly line of State Route No. 14 (formerly State Highway No. 8); thence in a northeasterly direction along the northerly line of said State Route to the intersection with the east line of said Section 26; thence north along section line to the point of beginning; EXCEPT two tracts conveyed to the State of Washington by deeds recorded at page 432 of Book "Y" of Deeds and page 548 of Book "Z" of Deeds, respectively, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

AND: In Section 26: Beginning at a point 700 feet south and 360 feet west of the quarter corner on the east line of said Section 26, which said point is on the west boundary line of State Route No. 14 (formerly State Highway No. 8) where there is a post of fir 3 inch in diameter marked "S" bearing from a fir tree 8 inch in diameter 22 feet northeast from said post also marked "S" meaning the south corner; thence from said post in a southerly direction along the westerly line of said State Route No. 14 (formerly State Highway No. 8) a distance of 50 feet; thence north 74° west a distance of 300 feet; thence north 16° east a distance of 50 feet; thence north 74° west a distance of 257 feet; thence north 16° east a distance of 350 feet, more or less, to the southerly line of said Kuffler Road, thence in an easterly direction along the southerly line of said Kuffler Road to the intersection with the westerly line of said State Route No. 14 (formerly State Highway No. 8); thence in a

AND: In Section 36: That portion of Government Lot 3 lying northerly and easterly of the center of Little Creek and all shorelands in front of, and abutting, this tract;

PROVISIONS

All conditions and requirements contained in reports of examination or permits previously issued apply to this certificate unless specifically noted below.

The well access port shall be maintained at all times.

An approved metering device shall be installed and maintained in accordance with RCW 90.03.360, 90.44.490 and WAC 508-64-020 through -040. Meter readings shall be recorded at least monthly.

Issuance of this water right is subject to the implementation of the minimum requirements established in the Conservation Planning Requirements, Guideline and Requirements for Public Water Systems Regarding Water Use Reporting, Demand Forecasting Methodology, and Conservation Programs, July 1994, and as revised.

Under RCW 90.03.005 and 90.54.020(6), conservation and improved water use efficiency must be emphasized in the management of the state's water resources, and must be considered as a potential new source of water. Accordingly, as part of the terms of this water right, the applicant shall prepare and implement a water conservation plan approved by Department of Health. The standards for such a plan may be obtained from either the Department of Health or the Department of Ecology.
