OPEN SPACE LAND MEANS EITHER:

- a) any land area so designated by an official comprehensive land use plan adopted by any city or
- b) any land area, the preservation of which it its present use would: (i) conserve and enhance natural or scenic resources; (ii) protect streams or water supply; (iii) promote conservation of soils, wetlands, beaches, or tidal marshes; (iv) enhance the value to the public of abutting or neighboring parks, forests, wildlife preserves, nature reservations or sanctuaries or other open space; (v) enhance recreation opportunities; (vi) preserve historic sites; (vii) preserve visual quality along highway, road, and street corridors or scenic vistas; or (viii) retain in its natural state tracts of land not less than one acre situated in an urban area and open to public use on such classification; or
- c) any land that meets the definition of farm and agricultural conservation land. Agricultural land also includes (i) land on which appurtenances necessary for the production, preparation, or sale of commercial agricultural products are situated when the appurtenances are used in conjunction with the land(s) producing agricultural products, (ii) land incidentally used for an activity or enterprise that is compatible with commercial agricultural purposes as long as the incidental use does not enceed twenty percent of the classified land, and (iii) any noncontiguous parcel of land from one to five across in size that constitutes an integral part of the commercial agricultural operations of a classified parcel of farm and agricultural land.

I/we declare that I am/we are ware of the liability of withdrawal or removal of this land from classification to the following extent:

- 1. If the owner has filed the proper notice of request to withdraw the classified land and the land has been classified for a minimum of ten years he/she shall pay an amount equal to the difference between the plus interest at the same statutory rate charged on delinquent property taxes. The additional tax and interest is all be paid for the preceding seven years.
- 2. If and is removed from classification because of a change to a non-conforming use, land is removed prior to the minimum ten year period, or land is removed because the owner(s) falled to comply with the two year notice of vithdrawal he/she shall be liable to pay the additional tax and interest described in 1 above plus a penalty of twenty percent of the additional tax and interest. The additional tax, and penalty shall be paid for the preceding seven years.
- The additional tax, interest, and/or penalty shall not be imposed if the withdrawal or removal from classification resulted solely from:
 - a) transfer to a government entity in exchange for other land located within the state of Washington;
 - a taking inrough the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or sale or transfer to an entity having the power of eminent domain in anticipation of the exercise of this power, said entity having manifested its intent in writing or by other official action;
 - a natural disaster such as a flood, windstorm, earthquake, or other calamity rather than by virtue of the act of the landowner changing the use of the classified land;
 - official action by an agency of the state of Washington or by the county or city within which the land is located that disallows the present classified use of the land;
 - e) transfer of land to a church when the land would qualify for exemption pursuant to RCW 84.36.020;
 - f) acquisition of p. perty interests by a state or federal agency, county, city, town, metropolitan

- a) CLASSIFIED FOREST LAND is land whose highest and best use s the growing and harvesting of timber.
- b) DESIGNATED FOREST LAND is land that is primarily devoted to and used for growing and harvesting timber but whose value for other purposes may be greater than its value for use as forest land.

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I/we declare that I am/we are aware of the liability of removal of this land from classification or designation and upon removal a compensating tax shall be imposed that shall be equal to the difference between the amount of tax last levied on the land as forest land and an amount equal to the new assessed valuation of the land multiplied by the millage rate of the last levy extended against the land, multiplied by a number, not greater than ten, equal to the number of years the land was classified or designated as forest land.
