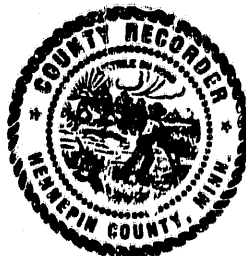

Dear Ms. Canon:

This is the official certification of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) to purchase certain assets and certain liabilities of Northwest National Bank, Vancouver, Washington by U.S. Bank National Association, Minneapolis, Minnesota, effective as of March 13, 1999. The resulting bank title is "U.S. Bank National Association" and Charter Number is 13405.

This is also the official authorization given to U.S. Bank National Association to operate the branches of the target institution. Branches of a national bank target are not listed since they are automatically carried over to the resulting bank and retain their current branch numbers. If a branch is closed, a 90-day advance notice of the proposed branch closing must be submitted to the OCC pursuant to 12 USC 1831r-1. Following the expiration of the 90-day notification period, a copy of this authorization must be surrendered. Additionally, if a branch is sold, a copy of the branch authorization should be surrendered to the OCC.

The bank should change its legal lending limit calculation as of March 13, 1999.
