II. ORDER AND JUDGMENT

Plaintiff's motion for an order of default and default judgment against the above named defendants came on for hearing on this date before the undersigned judge/court commissioner of this court. The court, having found that: (1) the defendant was duly served with a summons and complaint and have failed to appear, answer, or otherwise defend within the time provided by law; (2) finds that the venue is proper; and (3) the defendant is justly indebted to the plaintiff, as evidenced by the proof presented herewith, now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that plaintiff have and is hereby granted judgment against defendant, LYNNE D GREEN and her marital community, jointly and severally, in the principal amount of \$2,707.19, plus interest of \$328.10, court costs and disbursements totalling \$150.10, and reasonable attorneys' fees of \$750.00, for a total judgment of \$3,935.39.
