One 9 1/2 x 11 Willamette Logging Donkey Engine complete, together with all the wire cable, blocks, hooks, and everything pertaining to the same, to make a complete logging outfit for one Donkey Engine situated and being on Section 17 Tp. 2 N. R. 5 E. W. M. in Skamania County, Washington.

To Have and to Hold, the same to the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I do, for myself my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
