

Ziegler to Hood Road Assn.

This Memorandum of an agreement made and entered into by and between the undersigned I.R.Ziegler of Underwood, Wash. and The Hood Road Association of Underwood Wash. witnesseth: That whereas the said I.R.Ziegler has subscribed the sum of \$160.00 dollars to be paid to the Hood Road Association toward the building of the Roads known as Hood Road and Buck Creek Road, and whereas the Hood Road Association has accepted my notes for the said amount so subscribed, now therefore I hereby agree with the said Hood Road Association in consideration of the above that I will not dispose of the real estate owned by me or incumber the same or any part thereof without first liquidating the indebtedness secured by said notes or making satisfactory arrangements with said Hood Road Association concerning the same. And for the purpose of securing said association I hereby certify that I am the owner of the following property consisting of 120 acre more or less on which there is no incumbrance: SE 1/4 of sec. 5 Tp. 3 N. R. 16 E. W. N.

Attwell to Ash.

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 17th. day of March 1910 between John W. Attwell, party of the first part, and E.P.Ash, party of the second part witnesseth;

That it is mutually agreed between the parties hereto that the partnership heretofore existing between the said parties is wholly dissolved, and terminated.

That the said party of the first part transfers all interest in and to the mercantile business of the said partnership at Stevenson to the said party of the second part, together with all accounts owing the said firm and all exigences of indebtedness to the said firm. Also certain real property in the Town of Stevenson, set forth more fully in deed bearing even date hereof.

That the said party of the second part assumes all liability of the said firm and agrees to pay the same, and to hold the said party of the first part harmless for and on account of the same.

That the said party of the second part has conveyed to the said party of the first part certain real property in Portland, Multnomah county, Oregon, more fully described in deed of even date hereof.
