Moore and Les Moore of Stevenson Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty-seven ^{and 25/100} Dollars to us in hand paid by the firm of Maier & Schanno of The Dalles Oregon, and the further delivery of the Wood hereinafter mentioned to the said firm of Maier & Schanno at what is known as Nelson Creek Wood Landing on the North Bank of the Columbia River about 4 miles East of Stevenson Wash. have bargained sold and transferred and do by these presents grant, sell and transfer to the said firm of Maier & Schanno all of the following described personal property to-wit:

Christie Nine Cord of Fir Wood (Four feet Six Cord Wood) now being on what is known as the S. L. Moore land or farm about three miles North of Nelson Creek Wood Landing on the North Bank of the Columbia River, four miles East of the town of Stevenson, Wash.

So Have and do sold the said personal property unto the said firm of Maier & Schanno, their successors and assigns forever and the said Mrs. S. L. Moore, and Les Moore hereby covenant to and with said firm of Maier & Schanno that they are the lawful owners of said property, that the same is free from all encumbrance and that they have a good right to sell the same.
