In consideration of the agreements and covenants he relnafter set forth, said Walkers lease to said Wills for a terms of five years with privilege of five years more, pending the instalment of a better water system for the town of Stevenson, the right to enter upon and along the west part of their land, described as follows: Commencing at a point ten (10) chains south of the NE corner of tot three (3) Sec. 26 Tp. 3 N.R. 7 E.W. . , running the ce south 62 chains thence west 15-75 chains, thence N 62 chains thence east 15..75 chains to place of beginning, 10 acres more or less, for the purpose of developing the spring waters of said land be means of pipes and tiles to be done in a way to use the least of ground necess ary all pipes and tiles to be covered with at least 12 inches of earth said wills to have right to pass to or from or along said springs and contemplated pipe line and to and from the souta line of said land along the most direct route on proper grade for diverting such water for use on diffining property, due dilligence being used to prevent damage to findes or crops. In consideration of which said Wills agrees to install and maintain without cost to said Walkers, their heirs or assigns a 1 inch pipe and fawcet near the south line of said land from which may be drawn water for house hold use without waste and use of domestic stock of the la d in question without waste, all improvements to remain on said land at end of this lease.
