Bill of Sale.

Know all men by these presents that Seattle Car & Foundry Company, a Corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, with its principal place of business at Seattle, Washington, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of twelve thousand five hundred fifty three and 88/100 dollars (\$12,553.88), lawful money of the United States of America, to it in hand paid by H. N. Jones and Frederick A. Kibbe, of Portland, Oregon, the parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, seventeen (17) sets of Logging trucks (34 trucks), 80,000 Capacity low type Hercules trucks, which trucks are in the possession of the parties of the second part at Hamilton Spur, Skamania County, Washington, which trucks are marked upon the sides with the name plates of the party of the first part.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns forever. and said party of the first part does for its successors and assigns covenant and agree with the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns against all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or or to claim the same.
