Hendorf, husband and wife, of Skamania County, Washington, for and in consideration of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, and other valuable consideration, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and convey, unto F. L. Tilly and F. A. Smith all of that personal property situated upon the premises owned by the grantors herein, situated in Section 16, Township 3, North, Range 10, East, in Skamania County, Washington, described as follows, to-wit:-

all household goods, farming implements, phonograph, fruit, hay, one team of horses, chickens, lumber that is being and will be delivered on said premises consisting of about 20,000 feet, all tools, harness, wagon, buggy, and stump machine.

To have and to hold, the same unto said F. L. Tilly and F. A. Smith, and unto their heirs and assigns forever.

We, the grantors, covenant that said property is free from all incumbrances; that we are the owners thereof and have a good and lawful right to sell same and will warrant and defend same against all lawful demands of all persons.
