Freeburg of Portland, Oregon, parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid, at or before the executing and delivery of this presents to Ulysses Freeburg, of Carson, Washington, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, 1 3/4" Studebaker Wagon, 1 2 1/2" Studebaker Wagon, 1 3 Seated Hack, 2 2 Seated Hacks, 1 Top Buggy, 1 Single Buggy, 1 Pole Buggy.

To have and to hold, the same unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators, and assigns forever, and we do for our heirs, executors and administrators Covenant and agree to and with said party of the second part, his, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to Warrant and defend the title of said property, goods and chattels, hereby sold unto the said party of the second part, his, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
