Know All Men By These Presents,
That we, Mrs. S. L. Moore and Leo Moore, for
and in consideration of the sum of One
Hundred ninety-five Dollars (\$195.00) to us paid
by the firm of Maier & Schanno, of The Dalles,
Oregon, \$175.07 of which is this day received in
cash, the balance of \$19.93 to be paid to us at
hereinafter stated: Have bargained, sold and
transferred and do By These Presents, bargain,
sell and transfer unto the said firm of
Maier & Schanno all of the personal property
as hereinafter described, to wit:

Sixty (60) cords of four foot firewood
wood now cut and corded on the premises
of Mrs. S. L. Moore and Leo Moore in Skamania
County, Washington.

To Have and To Hold the said
described personal property unto said firm
of Maier and Schanno, their, heirs, successors
and assigns forever.

And we hereby covenant to and with
the said firm of Maier & Schanno that we are
the sole owners of said property, that there
are no liens against the same, that we
have a good right to sell said property.

And we further covenant to deliver all of
said cord wood to the said firm of Maier &
Schanno at the Columbia River beach, at
Melson Creek, Washington, either in the fall
of 1915, or in the spring of 1916, the balance of the
purchase price, \$19.93, to be paid to us at and
upon the delivery of said wood to the firm
of Maier & Schanno at The Dalles, Oregon.
