Know all men by these Presents, that the Stevens Lumber Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto C. M. Yerkes, in consideration of One dollar and other valuable considerations all of the following described personal property to-wit: That certain sawmill, sawmill machinery and fixtures, tools and implements owned by the said Stevens Lumber Co. and situated on Smith Creek, about three miles east of Stevens, in Stevens County, State of Washington, and consisting of the saw mill, niggel, cedar, timber, cut-off-saws, roller bed, engines, boilers, conveyors, and all sawmill machinery belonging to or used in said sawmill; also the lumbering outfit, consisting of axil, hammer and straight edge, 2 extra 52" firsads saws, and all other saws belonging to or used in connection with said saw mill; 1 lumber truck, 2 yard cars, 1 steamboat truck; also all buildings including the sawmill buildings of said sawmill, messhouse, store and office building, 3 residences, 4 bunk houses with stores and 1 large barn and 2 buildings for employees at the river, and all other buildings belonging to said saw mill business or used in connection therewith, also all lumber platforms, east hooks, hammers and mauls, 1 long punney 7+5 x 7 with connecting also the blacksmith shop with power drill, vice, bellows, forge, hammers, etc., and the stock of iron on hand in said blacksmith shop; also 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ barrels of oil; also all logging tools, implements and machinery, including one road engine on sled 9 x 10 Hercules, 1 graving engine on sled 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 12 Glory, 1 graving engine on sled 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 12 Murray, together with all the cables and lines, yards, bushes, blocks, grabs, tackles, blocks, trip blocks, spuds, and all other equipment belonging to or used in connection with said engines; also 2 Davison jacks, all punneys, carthooks, bars, mauls, bucking and felling axes, sledges and mauls, and all other logging tools and implements belonging to said logging plant or used in connection therewith; also all the改善 in the yard belonging to said sawmill; also all the lumber in the lumber yard of said saw mill or at the river, and estimated at 250,000 feet or thereabout; also 1,000,000 feet of timber fallen in the woods, of which 250,000 feet is bucked up; also all sled wood piled along the fence or elsewhere on the premises; also all the stock of goods in the store and all the supplies in the residence belonging to said Stevens Lumber Company at said sawmill; also 1 bark and 3 wagons; also all flumes, sugar rods, and rights of way and banking ground and rights at the River now owned by said Stevens Lumber Company and used in connection with said sawmill business. also the steamer "William B" used for towing on the river, together with her tackle, apparel and furniture; also one 6x6 engine with boiler for hauling cars, and 1000 ft. of $\frac{1}{2}$ cable used with the same; also the repair outfit, consisting of moveable forgs, nail and tools. also 1 boathouse 1 bunk house and barn at Wyeth; also 1 planing machine (wood land) not yet set up; also all boom and boomed; also 4 extra pinions for boathulls all belting and all other tools, implements, machinery, goods and supplies, and all
