BLAZIER LOGGING CO. and CAPE HORN R.R.CO. TO WASHINGTON NORTHERN R.R.CO.

KNOW ALL MEN, That Whereas the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company, on the 10th day of November, 1908, executed a certain indenture with the Blazier Logging Company, a corporation, and the Cape Horn Railroad Company, a corporation, recorded on the 11th day of June, 1909, in Book 2 of Leases and Agreements at page 76 of the records

of Skamania County, State of Washington, wherein and whereby the said Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company granted unto the said Blazier Logging Company the right to build, maintain and operate one overhead railway crossing over and across the right of way and tracks then existing or that might thereafter be built of the said Spokane Portland & Seattle Railway Company at a point on its line of railway between the City of Vancouver in the State of Washington and the City of Pasco in the State of Washington, which point is at station 1595 56 on the line of said Railway Company between said cities as shown and delineated on a blue print map attached to the said indenture marked Exhibit "A"; for the particulars, terms and conditions of which indenture reference is hereby made thereto; and

WHEREAS all the rights and interests of the said Blazier Logging Company, a corporation, in and to the railroad heretofore owned, constructed and operated by them for the use of which the said crossing agreement was obtained, have by due and proper assignments and conveyances passed to and become vested in the Washington Northern Railroad Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of Oregon, and possession thereof is about to be delivered to the said Washington Northern Railroad Company:

NOW THEREFORE THIS WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the premises and of Five (\$5.00) Dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Blazier Logging Company and the Cape Horn Railroad Company do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said Washington Northern Railroad Company, all the rights, interests, privileges and immunities by them or either of them held or owned under or by virtue of said indenture of November 10th, 1908, above described; to the purpose and intent that the same may be exercised, held and owned by the said Washington Northern Railroad Company to the full extent as if the said Washington Northern Railroad Company was named in and was party to the said indenture instead of the said Blazier Logging Company and the Cape Horn Railroad Company.
