Know All Men By These Presents That J. C. Bailey and Beatrice A. Bailey his wife of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollars lawful money of the United States to us in hand paid, at or before the executing and delivery of these presents to Ellen Graham of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, and convey unto the said party of the second part her executor administrators and assigns the following described personal property to wit:- all furniture, dishes, stoves, canned fruit, groceries on hand, bedding and household equipment also all farming implements, garden tools.

Lawn mower, Chickens and stock on place, also all crops, grain and hay, with the following exceptions, 1 Mattress, pair of blankets, Morris Chair, clock & pictures, & sofa pillows, books and personal effects. The above and foregoing are being upon that certain property described as follows, Commencing at a point distant 42 rods East of the Northwest Corner of the 36¹/₄ of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 28, Twp. 3 North of Range 5 East of T.M. running thence East 38 rods to the center line of said sec. 28, thence south along said center line 63¹/₄ rods, thence west 38 rods, thence north 63¹/₄ rods to the place of beginning containing 15 acres, more or less.

To Have and To Hold the same unto the said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns forever.

And we do for our heirs, executors and administrators Covenant and Agree to and with said party of the second part her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of said property goods, and chattels hereby sold unto the said party of the second part her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
