Know All Men By These Presents,
 That Christian Calvert and Anna Calvert,
 his wife of Stevenson, Skamania County,
 Washington the parties of the first part, for
 and in consideration of the sum of Eleven
 Hundred (\$1100.00) Dollars, to them in hand
 paid by E. C. Howe, of same place, the party
 of the second part, the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, do by these presents
 grant, bargain, sell, convey and con-
 firm unto the said party of the second
 part, his executors, administrators and
 assigns an undivided one half interest in
 and to the following described personal
 property, located and being in County of
 Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit: "The
 saw mill and machinery, including
 engine, two boilers, one edger, one log haul,
 planer, and all machinery in and about
 the mill, also one donkey engine and
 cable, all located at Kage's spur, otherwise
 known as Thirteen Mile Point, in said
 County of Skamania; also in all standing
 timber ^{and part of the timber} now cut on the following described
 land, to-wit: The Southeast quarter (SE¹/₄) of
 the Southwest quarter (SW¹/₄) of Section Thirty
 (30); the North half (N¹/₂) of the Northeast
 quarter (NE¹/₄) of Section Thirty one (31), the South-
 west quarter (SW¹/₄) of the Southwest quarter (SW¹/₄)
 of Section Twenty-nine (29), the Northwest
 quarter (NW¹/₄) of the Northwest quarter (NW¹/₄), the
 South half (S¹/₂) of the Northwest quarter (NW¹/₄), and
 the North half (N¹/₂) of the Southwest quarter
 (SW¹/₄) of Section Thirty-two (32), all in Township
 Three (3) North Range Nine (9) East of the
 Willamette Meridian." The right to cut and
 remove any of said timber being hereby
 reserved by first parties, together with the right
 to use said machinery.

To Have and To Hold the same to the
 said party of the second part his executors,

Administrators and assigns, forever.

And Christian Aalvik and Anna Aalvik his wife, do for their heirs, executors and administrators, Covenants and agree to and with the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the use of such property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever, causing injury or to claim the same.
