## Menice to Aulvik

This Agre ment made this 28nd day of September 1910 between Ingeborg Meniece of Home walley Skamenia County Washington party of the first part, and Christian Aalvok of Stevenson Washington party of the second part witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the covenant hereinafter contained the said party of the first part hereby agrees to sell and the said party of the seone part hereby agrees to buy all the timber standing and being upon the land of the aparty of the first part described as follows: Commencing at a fir stake & chains north of the southwest corner of the J.K.McKeighan Homestead, more fully identified by a dog wood tree five inches in diameter marked with two notches, said tree being 25 kikns north of sad stake; also a maple tree marked in like manner four inches in diameter said tree being 36 liks southwest of said stake, running thence east 13 chains and 50 links, thence north 12 chains, thence east 12 chains, thence north 20 chains, thence west to the northwest corner of said homestead, there south 32 chains to place of beginning, contain ing 76 acres Said McKeighan Homestead being the lots numbered 2 and 3 and the east half of the southwest quarter of section wenty six townhip three North of Range eight East W.M. The said party of the set nd part hereby agrees to pay for said timber at the rate of thirty five cents per cord as follows: Twney five dollars upon delivery of this contract, ten dollars as soon as the firs, hundred cords is cut and measured, the balance to be paid as follows: as soon as each one hindred cord is out the same shall be measured are payment ther fore made before removed from the land of said first party. And the said party of the first part hereby agrees that the said party of the second part shall and may have such rights of way on over and across the said land as small be necessray and convei et to cut and remove the said timber and may at any time go upon the said premises for the purpose of se cutting and removing the said tim ber, provided however and the said rty of the second part hereby agrees that he will not damage any of the improvements upon the sa d land in so cutting andremoving said timber. And the said party of the first pat hereby covenants and agrees that the s id party of the secondpart shall and may have full period of threes years within with to remove the said timber and this contract shall remain in full force and . fect for the said period of three years, but thereafte: shall be mull and void. It is hereby agreed and understood that the said party of the first part shall have the right to sell any of theland above described subject to the terms of this contract, but such sales shall in no wise render void this agreement or any part thereof.
