S. Knox to Hsh.

Know all men by these presents: That whereas, S. D. Knox as Sheriff of Skamania County, State of Washington, did on the 13th day of April, 1917, levy and distrain the Personal Property hereinafter described being the personal property of Hamilton Creek Timber Company, of Hamilton Creek, Washington, in said County, State of Washington, out of which to enforce the collection of those certain personal property taxes for the years, 1916 levied as follows:

Personal property taxes of Hamilton Creek Timber Co. for the year 1916, together with interest and costs amounting to \$1,532.30 and for the year 1916, said personal property taxes being assessed against the said Hamilton Creek Timber Co. and being delinquent and unpaid.

Whereas, the said S. D. Knox as Sheriff of said County, did on the 13th day of April, 1917, give due and public notice in the manner prescribed by law, that he had on the said day levied upon and distrained said personal property hereinafter described and that he would on the Twenty-eighth day of April, 1917, at Court House in said County, State of Washington, sell to the highest bidder for cash the said personal property to satisfy the full amount of said personal property taxes, assessments, interest and costs due thereon, and,

Whereas, three copies of said notice were posted at three of the most public places in said County more than ten days prior to the said 28th day of April, 1917 and,

Whereas, pursuant to said notice the said S. D. Knox as Sheriff of said County, Washington, did on the 28th day of April, 1917, sell the said personal property as provided for in said notice to E. P. Hsh., for the

sum of \$1532.30, the said C. P. Ash, then and there bidding the said sum of \$1532.30 which was the highest and best bid for cash received for said personal property.

Now, therefore, the said S. D. Knox, as Sheriff of said County, Washington, the party of the first part, and for and in consideration of the sum of \$1532.30 lawful money of the United States of America to him in hand paid by the said C. P. Ash, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. P. Ash, party of the second part, his successors or assigns the following personal property assessed to Hamilton Creek Lbr. Co. to-wit:

Donkey and Logging engines, Pile Drivers, Hoisting engines, Railroad equipment, etc.

To have and to hold, the same unto the said party of the second part, his successors or assigns with all the rights and privileges of said party of the first part therein.
