

Kilgore By D. L. Knox - D. J. Finn.

Whereas, Under and by virtue of an execution, issued out of the Superior Court of the State of Washington, for Okanama County, on the 26th day of April, 1917, upon a judgment rendered in the above entitled court on the 26th day of April, 1917, in favor of M. Mc. Kinnon et al judgment creditors, and against Walter S. Kilgore et ux et al judgment debtors, for the sum of \$400.16 including costs; with interest and increased costs to be added; I, D. L. All the mill property known as "The Table Rock mill," situated on lots 1 and 2 on the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Tp. 2. N.R. 7. E. W.M. in Okanama County, Washington, and the boilers, engines, saws, belting, machinery, landings, roadways, tools, equipment, implements and all the appurtenances and particularly 1 Ames Engine 8 x 10, 1 Ames Engine 11 x 13, 1 Boiler 45 inches x 12 feet, 1 boiler 36 inches x 10 feet, 1 J. E. Martin & Co. Friction feed works,

3 steel head saws, and cut-off, 1 Edger, all shafting, pulleys and belting around the mills, blacksmith tools, range and stoves and carts, gear, 1 Donkey Engine, $9\frac{1}{2} \times 10$, lines, tools, blocks and flume to slough, about 200 $7\frac{1}{2}$ - 8 foot long sawed fir rail-road ties piled on the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company's right of way at or near the water tank at Cascades Station in said Shumania County, Washington, about 1500 feet board measure timbers at said mill, about 22000 feet, board measure, fir saw-logs at said mill and about 200 cords of slabwood at said mill, about 200,000 feet 1 m. fir saw-logs in the woods on said land.
