

Inventory to Bank of Stevenson

Know all men by these Presents that we, John F. This bill of sale is given to secure the payment of a promissory note for \$600.00 with interest thereon and can be redeemed within 90 days from date hereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said party of the second part, their successors and assigns forever. And we do for our heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, their successors and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby sold unto the said party of the second part, their successors and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
