 Know all men by these presents, that in consideration of \$180<sup>00</sup> dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I do hereby grant, sell and transfer, unto J. W. Inman, his heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns, the following goods and chattels, viz  
 One set head blocks, consisting of three in number 100<sup>00</sup>  
 One ratchet shaft 25<sup>00</sup>  
 One set of carriage Clogs three in number 25<sup>00</sup>  
 One three inch shaft with wood pulley and having 30<sup>00</sup> to have and to hold all and singular, the said goods and chattels forever, and the said grantor hereby warrants with said guarantee that he is the lawful owner of said goods and chattels, that they are free from incumbrances that he has good right to sell the same as aforesaid and that he will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever.
