The Foster Mill Co. to Wind River Lumber Co.

Know all men by these presents: That F. F. Foster, of Carson, Washington, doing business under the name and style of Foster Mill Company, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Fifty (\$650.00) Dollars, legal money of the United States of America, do by these presents Grant, Bargain sell, Convey and Confirm unto Wind River Lumber Company, a corporation, party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described personal property, located and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

That certain saw mill, complete except power, now located and being on the land at Carson in said Skamania County, Washington, known as the Walker place, and known as the Foster Mill, consisting of the following items:

- 1 Husk complete with Feed Gear and Saw Guide.
- 1 52" Wheel Head Saw.
- 1 Head saw arbor 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 10'4" With Saw Collars and 26" x 14" Cast Pulley
- 1 Complete Tightener for drive belt.

- 1 Feed cable with drum and two Tail Slices
- 60 ft double track, half rail, half strap.
