And I do for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of said property hereby made unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, against all and every person and persons, whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
