Wallace, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns the following described personal property owned by the party of the first part and now being all the cattle, owned by him on his farm situated about seven miles East of Stevenson, Washington to wit:

Thirteen (13) head of cows;

Eight (8) head two-year old heifers;

Eleven yearlings;

One yearling bull;

Eighteen sucking calves.

All the above cattle with the exception of the 18 sucking calves, branded "J. W" on the right hip and the right ear split.

Also the above brand and the right to use same which is now recorded as the property of the party of the first part and said party of the first part agrees to have necessary transfer of same on records.
