Witnesseth. For and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by the party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged: the party of the first part does at this time and by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto said party of the second part and assigns all the following described personal property to wit:

1 broken scrap hoisting engine;

250 feet of birch pipe;

All jacks and other pipe;

All scrap iron;

2 sets of junk logging trucks;

All roofing; all stoves; all blacksmith tools consisting of

1 forge, 1 drill press, 1 anvil and other tools;

1 scale; all cable; all scrap brass; and all tools consisting of track hammers, shovels, wrenches and other tools not enumerated herein;

All of which is located at Blazier's Logging Camp near town of Prindle County of State of Washington.

To Have And To Hold, the same to the said party of the second part and its assigns forever and I do for my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, convey and agree to and with said party of the second part, and its assigns to

Warrant and Defend the sale of the personal property hereby made unto the said party of the second part against every person or persons whomsoever may claim the same.
