I have and hold the sum unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I, do for my heirs, executors and administrators consent and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors and administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby sold unto said party of the second part against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.

Sullivan & Orson to S. L. & O. Co.

Stevens, Wash. Nov. 24. 1908

In consideration of one $\$1.00$ Dollar and other valuable considerations to us in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we do by these presents sell, assign and transfer to the Stevens Light & Power Company, corporation, the franchise granted to us by the Town of Stevens, and body Ordinance No. — of the Ordinances of the Town of Stevens, County date of Oct 13, 1903, passed November — 1908, and approved by the Mayor, and so transferred and assign to the said corporation all of the rights and privileges therewith required and granted to us, and said corporation shall to all of our interests in and to said franchise and be substituted in all places taken with all the duties and obligations resting upon us.
