

STATE OF WASHINGTON TO NORTHWESTERN ELECTRIC CO.

At a meeting of the Board of State Land Commissioners when were present the undersigned members, the following proceedings were had:

IN RE Application No. 8708 by the
NORTHWESTERN ELECTRIC COMPANY for
a Transmission Line Over and Across
the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec-
tion 10, Township 1 North, Range 5
East W.M., in Skamania County

O R D E R.

It appearing to the Board at this time that an application No. 8708 was filed in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands by the Northwestern Electric Company, a corporation, under the provisions of an act of the legislature approved March 17, 1909, being chapter 188 of the session laws of 1909; which application is for the appraisal of the value of certain state land in Skamania County and the improvements, if any, situated thereon, and the value of all merchantable timber, if any, standing thereon, included within the right-of-way therein described and within a radius of 200 feet on either side of said transmission line; that the land affected by and included within said application is described as follows:

All those portions of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, township 1 north, range 5 east W.M. which are included within the limits of a strip of land 62 feet in width, having 56 feet of such width on the northerly side and 6 feet on the southerly side of the following described line:

Beginning at a point on the west line of said section 10, said point being 50 feet south of the northwest corner of said section 10, and running thence south 89° 30' east, 640 feet and south 79° 23' east, 3406 feet to a point on the north ^{south} and center line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 10, said point being 700 feet south of the northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 10, containing an area of 5.84 acres, according to the plat on file in the office of the Commissioners of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Subject, however, to the right-of way for State Road across said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as shown on Plat No. 44 filed June 12, 1909;
and

It further appearing from said application that the applicant is a corporation, constructing or proposing to construct across said lands a transmission line for the purpose of generating and transmitting electricity for light, heat or power; that the land within the right-of-way so applied for is limited to an amount necessary for the construction of said transmission line sufficient for the purpose required, together with sufficient land on either side thereof for ingress and egress to maintain and repair the same; that there are no improvements thereon; that the full value of said lands, including the full value of all standing timber within a radius of 200 feet on either side of said proposed transmission line which may be dangerous to the operation and maintenance of the same is a total value of \$126.40; it is, therefore.

ORDERED and DETERMINED, That the full value of the land included in said application, together with the value of all merchantable timber standing within a radius of 200 feet on either side thereof, be and the same is hereby fixed and assessed at the sum of \$126.40

and upon payment of the above amount to the Commissioner of Public Lands by said Northwestern Electric Company, the right, privilege, power and authority to construct, operate and maintain a transmission line upon and over the lands above described, including the right to cut all standing timber within a radius of 200 feet on either side of said transmission line which may be dangerous to the operation and maintenance of the same, may be exercised in accordance with the statute.
