do hereby Bargain, Sell and Deliver unto
the said Broughton & Wiggins Co., a co-part-
nership, their executors, administrators and
assigns all of the hereinafter described
personal property ^{purchased} by me at sheriff's sale on
the 27th day of September, 1919, upon foreclosure
of a mortgage against Oregon Fir Lumber
Company, an Oregon corporation, which said
sale has also been ratified by a bill of sale
from the said Oregon Fir Lumber Company,
said property hereby sold being described as
follows, to wit:

- 4 54 inch circular saws with frame, saw buck
carriage, head blocks and all equipment;

- 1 60 in. x 16 ft. boiler;

3 Cut-off saws and arbors;

1 Trimmer, saw and arbors and all cables and all other machinery, tools, cook-house equipment and all other personal property now located in and about the sawmill at Willard, Itasca County, Washington except 2700 feet of 3/8 inch. trip line and 90 feet of 3/8 inch line holding up the conveyors together with the sheave on the end of conveyors.
