And the party of the first part does for his heirs, executors and administrators, covenant and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, his executors administrators and assigns to Warrant and Defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby made, unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
