

SAMSON TO WILLS
C O N T R A C T.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into on this the 7th day of February, 1914, by and between Sam Samson of Stevenson, Washington, and P.S.C.Wills of Coons, Washington,

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar paid by Sam Samson to P.S.C.Wills, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in the further consideration of the execution and delivery to the respective parties of assignment of right of ways and of water rights, and of bills of sale, and the settlement and adjustment of that certain action pending in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for Skamania County wherein P.S.C.Wills is plaintiff and Sam Samson is defendant, and for all of said consideration, it is hereby mutually agreed by and between the undersigned, as follows, to-wit:

That that certain lease dated the 20th day of May, 1909, made by and between P.S.C. Wills, the undersigned, and Sam Samson, the undersigned, and recorded on the 3rd day of June, 1909, in Book 2, page 68 of the Records of Leases and Agreements in the office of the County Auditor of said County and State, is hereby cancelled and annulled, surrendered, delivered up and held for naught, and the said P.S.C.Wills does hereby release the said Sam Samson from any and all liability under and by virtue thereof, and the said Sam Samson does hereby release the said P.S.C.Wills from any and all liability thereunder, or by reason thereof.
