

JONES TO HAMILTON

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Myrtle Attwell, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I hereby sell, transfer, assign and set over unto the said Myrtle Attwell, her heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to the rentals due or to become due to me as a heir of the S.M. and Mary J. Hamilton estate as lessors in and to that certain lease to the Cascade Railroad Company dated Nov. 4 1879 and now of record in book C of deeds of page 56, records of Skamania County, Washington.

This assignment is made as security to a loan of \$500. this day made to me by the said Myrtle Attwell and it is understood and agreed that out of the monthly rental payments due or to become due under the said lease aforesaid, that my interest therein, to-wit a one seventh interest therein as a heir of said Hamilton estate, shall be paid over to and received for by the said Myrtle Attwell and the amount thereon credited upon said loan, for which loan she holds my note in said sum of \$500. dated this Oct. 13, 1914 and due on or before one year after date.

It is understood and agreed that upon the payment of said loan or the balance due thereon after the crediting of said monthly payments that this assignment shall be cancelled and all of my rights in and to the rentals due under the terms of said lease restored to their former condition.

This assignment to continue in force until the full amount of principal and interest has been satisfied and discharged.
