CHRIST ET AL TO AMERICAN FREEHOLD-LAND/CO.

EXTENSION AGREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1st day of October A.D. 1915, between Fannie H. Christ and Philip Christ (her husband) and William H. Harper and Ira H. Harper, (her husband) parties of the first party and The American Freehold Land Mortgage Company of London Limited, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of Great Britain and Ireland, party of the second part, WITNESSETH: WHEREAS, Thomas W. Atkinson and Mary E. Atkinson (his wife, did on or about the 19th day of July A.D. 1912, execute a certain promissory note

for the sum of Three thousand and no/100 (\$3000.^{no}₀₀) Dollars to the said party of the second part, and did execute a certain mortgage to secure the said note, which mortgage was filed for record in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County in the State of Washington, and is recorded in Book "L" of Mortgages of said county, at page 160 thereof.

AND WHEREAS, Said parties of the first part are now the owners in fee simple of the lands covered by said mortgage,

AND WHEREAS, There has been paid on account of the principal of said mortgage, the sum of One thousand and No/100 (\$1000.^{no}₀₀) Dollars and parties of the first part desire an extension in the time of payment of the unpaid part of said principal secured thereby,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED between the parties hereto that the sum of Two thousand and no/100 (\$2000.^{no}₀₀) Dollars of the principal of said indebtedness is unpaid and that parties of the first part are personally liable for it and agree to pay said sum in the following manner, to-wit: \$2000.^{no}₀₀ on 1st October 1917.

with interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum, as evidenced by 4 extension interest notes this day executed by the parties of the first part and falling due semiannually on the first day of April and October at the office of said party of the second part at London, England and that said mortgage shall stand as security for said sums, with interest as aforesaid, and said second party hereby agrees to the extension of the payment of said principal indebtedness as aforesaid.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the principal sum of said indebtedness may be declared due for default in the payment of interest or principal when due, or for violation of any covenants contained in said mortgage, and that in each and every respect the said promissory note and the said mortgage shall stand and remain in full force and effect as originally written, being modified only as above provided.
