

## WALKER TO STEVENSON WATER CO.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 16th day of March, 1916, by and between C.D. Walker and Delia Walker, his wife, and The Stevenson Water Company, a corporation, of Stevenson, Washington, Witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of \$1.00 and the benefits to be derived from piping water to be served said Walker at the most favored customer rate, a right of way is hereby granted The Stevenson Water Company, its successors and assigns, for a period of twenty-five<sup>(25)</sup> years to lay and maintain in good order water pipes, over and along the following described route: Beginning at a point in Section 36, Township 3 North of Range 7 East of W.M., which is on south line of said Walker's land at a point 10 feet west of the N.E. corner of Roosevelt Street thence north 51 degrees 56' W. 150 feet, thence north 58 degrees 09' east 282 feet, thence North 37 degrees 59' W. 200 feet more or less to intersection with south line of Dempsey Taylor tract.

Such pipe to be laid 18 inches below surface of ground, out of reach of damage by future clearing or plowing, and maintained in good order so as to prevent damage to land or crops all stumps to be shot out along pipe ditch at time of digging same.

Grantee herein agrees to place, for future service, three 12 inch Ts in pipe on C.D. Walker's tract above mentioned. C.D. Walker to designate in writing at the present time where said Ts are to be located on S. line & 200 ft. next above & 200 ft. next above as near as couplings make it feasible.

## DEMPSEY TAYLOR TO STEVENSON WATER CO.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 16th day of March, 1916, by and between Dempsey Taylor, party of the first part and The Stevenson Water Company, a corporation, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of \$1.00 and the benefits to be derived from piping water to be served said Taylor at the most favored customer rate, a right of way is hereby granted The Stevenson Water Company, its successors and assigns for a period of Twenty five (25) years, to lay and maintain in good order water pipes, over and along the following described route: Beginning at iron pipe post in center of Section 36 Township 3 North Range 7 E.W.M., thence south

4 deg. 33' E. 258 feet, thence south 00 deg. 43' W. 315 feet, thence south 37 deg. 59' E. 131 feet more or less to intersection with line of C.D. Walker's land.

Each pipe to be laid 18 inches below surface of ground, out of reach of damage by future clearing or plowing, and maintained in good order so as to prevent damage to land & crops all pumps to be shot out along pipe line ditch at time of digging same.

The party of the second part agrees to place, for future service, two Ts in pipe on Dempsey Taylor's tract above mentioned. Dempsey Taylor to designate in writing at the present time where said Ts are to be located. Viz. opposite the NE & SE corners of Tom Combs land.

#### AALVIK TO STEVENSON WATER CO.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 16th day of March, 1916, by and between Christian Aalvik and Anna Aalvik, his wife, parties of the first part and the Stevenson Water Company, a corporation, of Stevenson, Washington, party of the second part. Witnesseth.

That for and in consideration of two months of domestic water service at any time desired by Christian Aalvik his heirs, or assigns per year from any one of (4) Four Ts placed as requested from one half inch faucet a right of way is hereby granted to Stevenson Water Company its successors and assigns, for a period of twenty five years, for laying and maintaining water pipes as at present laid with the knowledge and consent heretofore given by said Aalvik over and along the following described route:

Beginning 75 feet west of the E corner of lot #4 of Hoves Orchard Homes Subdivision, thence S. 72 deg. 24' W. 80 feet, thence S. 44 deg. 36' W. 320 feet, thence S. 2 deg. 38' E. 348 ft thence S 37 deg. 19' W. 100 ft. thence S 33 deg. 20' E. 62 ft. thence S. 67 deg. 00' 82 ft. thence S. 34 deg. 16' E. 123 ft. or less to reservoir tract line.

Said pipe to be maintained in good order as at present depth, free from damage to land or crops. In case of failure or will full neglect to supply water as agreed, all rights hereby granted are forfeited and terminated.
