#### NELSON TO GEORGE.

AN AGREEMENT, entered into this the third day of January 1912, by and between Robert Nelson and Rosa B. Nelson his wife of Collins Wn. and O.C. George of Portland, Oregon.

Robert Nelson & Rosa Nelson parties of 1st part O.C. George party of second part. Parties of first part hereby agree to lease or rent to party of second part the following described property. North east  $\frac{1}{4}$  of lot 1 of section 32 of Township 3 Range 9 east about eight acres and right of way for road and pipe line across the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Lot 1 of Sect. 32 T.S. 3 of Range 9 East for a term of 5 five years from Jan. 3rd 1912, same terminating Jan. 3rd. 1917, for construction and operation of a sawmill in consideration of the followingservices to be performed by party of second part. and payment of one dollar which is hereby acknowledged.

Party of second part agrees in payment for use or lease of said property to furnish water for irrigation of garden tract to the extent of a 1 inch water pipe stream either pumped from river or run from reservoir beginning the first day of June and until the 31st day of August of each year for four hours each day at such time as shall suit the convenience of party of second part and while mill is in operation.

Party of second part not to be held for supply of water unless operating mill at time called for in this agreement. All build erected from time to time to remain the property of party of second part and to be removed at his will.

WENDORF TO PERRY

AN AGREEMENT made and entered into on this 1st day of March, 1916 by and between Helen L. Wendorf, Party of the First Part, and Henry Perry, Party of the second Part;

WITNESSETH: That the Party of the First Part; being the owner of a certain farm in Skamania Co. Washington, described as follows:-

Beginning at the Quarter corner on the East line of Section 16, Tp. 3 N. Rg 10 E.W.M. thence West on the  $\frac{1}{4}$  line for a distance of 56 rods, thence North 40 rods, thence West 64 rods, thence South 40 rods, thence East 40 rods, thence South 80 rods, thence East 45 rods thence North 48 rods, thence East 45 rods, thence North 48 rods, thence East 35 rods to the west line of said Section 16, thence North along said line 32 rods to the point of beginning, agrees to rent said farm to the said Henry Perry for a period of one year from the date of this instrument for the sum of \$125.00 cash.

The Party of the second Part agrees to pay to the Party of the First Part the sum of \$125.00 as rental for the said farm for the term of one year. The Party of the Second Part agrees to take out certain trees to be designated by the Party of the First Part, and to repair all the outside fences belonging to the farm.

For doing this work the Party of the First Part agrees to pay the Party of the Second Part, the sum of \$5.00 per day of 10 hours for himself, team and stump puller while removing said trees, and the sum of \$2.50 per day (10 hours) for hand work repairing fence etc, and for helper while removing said trees, said helper to receive his pay from the Party of the Second Part who hereby agrees to relieve the Party of the First Part from all obligation for the wages of said helper. All these sums of money that may become due the Party of the Second Part by reason of any work done as above mentioned to be credited to the said
