It being the intention to convey hereby all right, title and interest in and to the mercantile business of the firm of Ash and Attwell, unto the said party of the second part.

To have and To hold the same unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I do for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators, and assigns, against all lawful claims to the same.
