Young, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of second part the following described personal property - to-wit:

All the furniture and bedding in the Hotel at Collins Hot Springs Hotel, office fixtures & safe, all the buildings including the Hotel building, Bath house, Store and outhouse, Boarding place, Post Office, 24 Poles and fence, and bedding for same, stored in Bath house, all dining room furniture, dishes etc. and all cooking utensils and Range in the kitchen, 7 head of horses, 2 Wagons, 1 Buglehead Wagon, and 2 set double harness and 1 single set harness, 9 Milk cows, 2 two year old heifers, 1 bull, all the hogs on the place, Power house and electrical plant and steam pump plant. The intention of the seller hereby being to sell and transfer everything he owns in and about said Collins Hot Springs with the exception of horses or not.

To have and to hold, the same to the said party of the second part, his heirs, assigns and assigns forever. And I do, for my heirs, assigns and assigns, covenant and agree to and with the said party of second part his heirs and assigns, to warrant and defend the title of said property, goods and chattels against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
