 blocks & ropes, 46 meat hooks, 4 hog scrapers & water and brine testers, 1 round
 needle, 3, black scrapers, 1 joint stone, 2 mangles 1 roller, 1 set knives & shovels,
 1 mangle, 2 hog forks, 1 saw beam, 2 beam holders, 5 paper cutters, 6 meat
 racks, 3 counters, 2 meat blocks, 2 meat rollers, 1 plain kettle, 3 galvanized
 tubs, 4 cleavers, 1 partition in building, 2 electric wiring in building 4 cleavers,
 2 axes, 3 set scales (1 platform scale) 1 25 foot hose, 1 50 foot hose, 1 sand
