Greuburg of Canon, Wash, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto and part of second part, his heirs and assigns all the following personal property goods and chattels located in that certain living house known as the Snyder Living Room in Canon, Okla. Co. Wash, to-wit:

9 140 lbs Hay, 15 sacks of corn, 19 sacks of oats, 20 sacks of barley, 1 black horse named Bailey aged about 7 years weight 1050 pounds; 1 black horse named Spencer aged about 7 years weight 1000 pounds, 1 bay horse named Sandy aged 6 years 1 bay horse named Doc, aged 7 years weight 1000 pounds, 1 brown horse named Peggy aged 3 years weight 1050 pounds, 1 white horse named Rosdy aged 8 years weight 1050 pounds, 1 brown horse named Mike weight about 1000 pounds, 1 black horse named Bill, aged 7 years weight 1000 pounds 1 bay horse named Jack aged 8 years, 1000 pounds, 1 new wagon, 1 old wagon. 1 3-wheeled truck, (John Deere make) 2 2-wheeled trucks, 3 1-wheeled buggies, 8 saddles, 2 back saddles, 4 sets double harness 1 single harness, 9 riding bridles, 3 heavy rollers, 3 light rollers, 1 stone, 2 spring seats, 5 riding skirts, 1 horse blanket 2 horses --- and all other goods tools and personal property of every kind now in said house or used in said living business or connection therewith.
