To have and to hold to have to the said party of second part her executors administrators and assigns; and that she do, her heirs executors administrators and assigns covenant and agree to and with the said party of second part, her heirs and assigns to warrant and defend the title of said property, goods and chattels hereby made and the said party of second part her heirs and assigns against all and any persons or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
