Bush Donation Land Claims, Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), and Nine (9), in Section Ten (10), Lots Six (6) of Section Fourteen (14), Lots Two (2), and Seven (7) of Section Fifteen (15) in Township Two (2) North, Range Seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian, and all lying in Skamania County, Washington.

It being the intent by this instrument to assign and deliver unto the said J. O. Elrod all personal property of every kind whatsoever, together with all rights, privileges, easements that the grantor herein has in the management of its business in Skamania County, Washington.
