Bill of Sale.

Know All Men By These Presents, That I, Sam Samson and Flora Samson, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, to each of us paid by P. S. C. Wille, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in the further consideration of other valuable considerations passing between, and other mutual covenants and agreements this day made by and between, the parties hereto, each of us do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said P. S. C. Wille, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, all of the following described personal property situate and being in this County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

All of the water pipe and piping of any and all kinds, sizes and description now in, upon or about the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 27, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, of the Willamette Meridian Skamania County, Washington, and from said tract of land in, about and upon any and all right of ways to the corner of Vancouver Avenue and Russell Avenue, in the Town of Stevenson, Washington; also all of said pipe or piping now used in conveying water from Cedar Creek to said pipe line; and also all pipe, fixtures, fittings, couplings, connections and all other parts used in connection with said pipe and piping but no pipe, piping, pipe line fixtures, fitting, couplings or connections East or South of said corner of Vancouver Ave. and Russell Ave. is included, herein.

To Have, and To Hold said personal property unto the party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to and for his own proper use and behoof forever.

And the said parties of the first part for himself and herself covenants and warrants that the parties of the first part are the true and lawful owners of said personal property, and every part and parcel thereof, and have just and lawfully right, power and authority to dispose of said personal property, and does covenant and agree to and with the party of the second part, that said personal property and every part thereof, is free from all claims, liens, demands and incumbrances from any and all persons whatsoever.
