

Inman to Maier & Schanno

Know all Men By These Presents, That I, R. F. Inman, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars, to me paid by the firm of Maier & Schanno of The Dalles, Oregon, \$60.00 of which is this day received in cash and the balance of \$290.00 to be paid to me as hereinafter stated, have bargained, sold and transferred, and do by these presents bargain, sell and transfer unto the said firm of Maier & Schanno all of the personal property as hereinafter described, to-wit:

One hundred (100) cords of four foot fir cord wood, now cut and corded on the premises of Inman Bros. on Nelson Creek in Skamania County, Washington.

To Have and To Hold the said described personal property unto the said firm of Maier & Schanno, their heirs, successors and assigns forever.

And I hereby covenant to and with the said firm of Maier & Schanno that I am the sole owner of said property, that there are no liens against the same, and that I have a good right to sell said property.

And I further covenant to deliver all of said property to the said firm of Maier & Schanno at the Columbia River Beach at Nelson Creek, Washington, on or before the 30th day of October, 1914, the balance of the purchase price of \$290.00 to be paid to me at and upon the delivery of said wood to the firm of Maier & Schanno at The Dalles, Oregon.
